### **PhD Research Position in International Economic Policy**

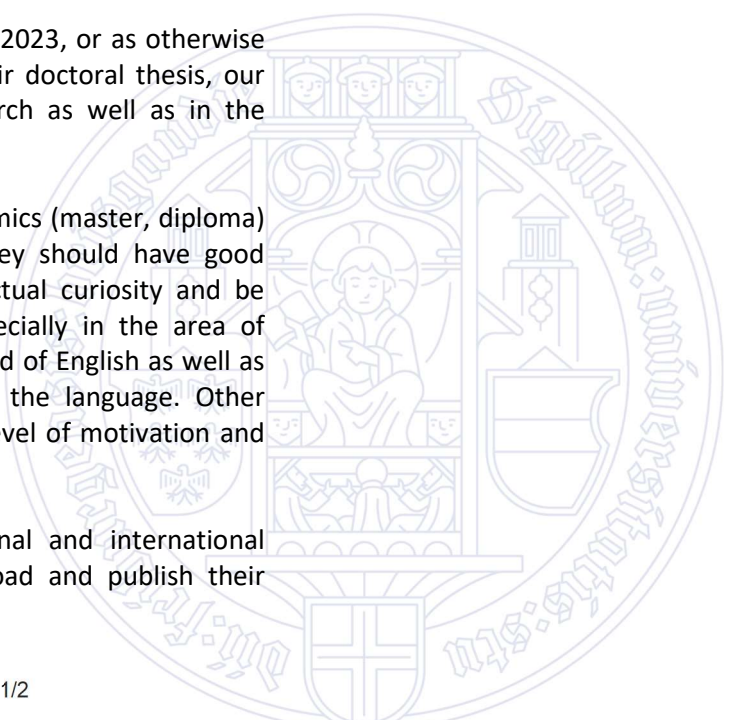
Part-time position (50 %) Start-date: 01.11.2023
