## Postdoctoral Researcher (m/f/d) in the DFG-funded long-term project TVSEP (Salary Scale 13 TV-L, 100 %)

starting on 01.04.2024, or at the earliest possible date. The position is limited to 3 years, with the possibility of an extension.

### The TVSEP project

The long-term project of the Thailand Vietnam Socio-Economic Panel (TVSEP) is funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG) (see: <https://www.TVSEP.de>). It is a unique and comprehensive primary data project that started in 2006 and includes up to 8 waves of data on about 4,400 rural households in 440 villages in Thailand and Vietnam. Two further waves of the household panel and one additional wave of migrants are to be collected in the following three years. TVSEP promotes research on topics such as the long-term consequences of shocks, migration, and rural transformation.

### Responsibilities and duties

The position is intended for management activities and research within the TVSEP long-term project. The tasks include organizing household data collections in Thailand and Vietnam, data cleaning and analysis (using the statistical software Stata), creating the online questionnaire in Survey Solutions, communicating with project partners abroad, doing own research and promoting research collaboration in an international team and providing support to the organization of workshops and conferences. The position involves extensive travel in Thailand and Vietnam.

### Employment conditions

The prerequisite is a completed university science degree in economics, agricultural economics or related fields and a very good publication record. Furthermore, a relevant completed doctorate is expected. In addition, the applicant has experience in on-site data collection (CAPI) and very good knowledge of econometrics and panel data analyses with Stata. Knowledge of programming languages, especially Survey Solutions, is an advantage. Excellent written and spoken English skills are required (knowledge of German, Thai or Vietnamese is an advantage). A strong interest in research on topics of rural transformation, climate change, the environment, migration or globalization is required, as is flexibility, initiative and teamwork in an international research team.

The university aims to promote equality between women and men. For this purpose, the university strives to reduce under-representation in areas where a certain gender is under-represented. Women are under-represented in the salary scale of the advertised position. Therefore, qualified women are encouraged to apply. Moreover, we welcome applications from qualified men. Preference will be given to equally-qualified applicants with disabilities.
